Marine Table Tennis Mini League

Rules

1. Only individuals who are Members of Bath Street Marine Table Tennis Club may participate in the Mini League
2. Teams can be any 3 players whose standard of play is not higher than Div 4 of the LDTTL in the 2019/20 season of that League. Any player who played in Div 4 or 5 of LDTTL in 2019/20 season is eligible and any other player of a similar or lower standard whether they played in the league or not. Each player shall be ranked within their squad by the Club Fixture Secretary and must play in that order. A substitute shall play in the position vacated by the person for whom they act as substitute. All players must have registered as a member of TTE prior to the commencement of the Mini League.
3. A match shall comprise of 6 sets of singles played in the following order:
3 v 3, 1 v 2, 2 v 1, 3 v 2, 2 v 3, 1 v 1
Each set shall be the best of 5 games played up to 11 points. The normal rules of table tennis will apply.
4. All matches shall be played on the scheduled date. No postponements, cancellations or rearrangements will be allowed. The only exception will be if the covid rules should change and impact upon match play.
5. All matches shall start at 7pm and be played at BSMTTC. Matches shall be played on a single table. Social Distancing shall be maintained throughout and in general the match should be played observing TTE Guidelines relating to corona virus. All participants playing in a match must enter their details in the booking diary at the club premises.
6. Every game won shall count as a 1 point. The points score for each team for a match shall therefore be determined by the number of games won.
7. A weekly table of results and team positions in the League will be maintained and published.
8. At the end of a match a copy of the score card shall be sent electronically (by email or Messenger) to the Club Fixture Secretary (gratur5gilmore@outlook.com).
9. A player from any team may act as a substitute for another team, without limit, if that team is unable to field any one or more of its regular squad members for a match. Another member of the club who is not named as a member of any team may also act as a substitute providing they are registered with TTE and they are of no higher standard than that set out in Rule 2.
10. On any matter not covered by these Rules the decision of the Club Fixture Secretary shall be final for the purpose of this competition.
